A former International Affairs Fellow with the Council on Foreign Relations based in Tokyo, Jonathan previously spent nearly a decade advising the Canadian federal government on economic and security issues across Asia, working across the foreign ministry and the security community. His former fellowships include the Asia-Pacific Foundation of Canada, the EastWest Institute, Pacific Forum CSIS, and Japan's National Institute of Defense Studies. He regularly participates in track 1.5 and track 2 dialogues across the Indo-Pacific.

Jonathan lectures worldwide to corporations, governments, and academic institutions, and is a trusted voice in global media.
